

The Institute may not incur any expenditures not included in the budget without the consent of the Finance Committee.

- > Estimates fees and other sources of revenue and Estimates the amount of money received from the UGC, AICTE, or any other financial source.
- > Prepares a daily budget plan for the institution's operations. Examines the budgets supplied by the various departments. and keep track of how the department's budget is spent. Considers the Institution's audited accounts and submits the audited accounts to AMCEC. Proposes the budget for the fiscal year for the departments and
