Feedback Analysis Report of all Stakeholders

The Feedback Analysis Committee of the institution designs and collects feedback from its stakeholders manually to monitor and evaluate its performance quality on curriculum design and implementation.

The feedback forms were collected from Students, Teachers, Alumni and Employers every year including the year 2020-21.

The feedback committee consolidated all the feedback reports collected from different stakeholders. The analysis report was prepared, and recommendations drawn for bring it to the notice of the IQAC and Governing Council.

The feedback targets following different questions for different stakeholders.

- For students, it addressed curriculum and its learning related issues in terms of quality, competence, and skills. This feedback also considers other issues like delivery of curriculum by teachers.
- For teachers, the feedback addressed issues like suitability of the course and its need base, outcomes of the curriculum, relationship with course content and corresponding reference material.
- For alumni, it aimed for responses on adequateness of courses curriculum, sufficiency of syllabus content in context of current professional standards and curriculum design in context of development of self-directed learning and problem-solving approach.
- For employers, it addressed issues like general communication skills, developing solutions to real life problems, working in a team, organization skills, learning of new techniques for work as learnt through the curriculum.
