

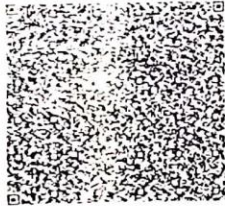

    5. Timetable Publishing\* tools enable you to effortlessly present schedule information for your customers
    6. Driver Training & Fuel Management\* ensures that drivers are safe and efficient with fuel
    7. Crew Planning and Management\* ensures that drivers are allocated
    8. through manual and automated roistering connected with HRMS

(b) **Non-Use and Non-Disclosure.** Consultant will not, during or subsequent to the term of this Agreement for 1 years, use the Nano Kernel's Confidential Information for any purpose whatsoever (other than the performance of the Services on behalf of the Nano Kernel) or disclose the Nano Kernel's Confidential Information to any third party unless approved by the Nano Kernel in writing. It is understood that said Confidential Information shall remain the sole property of the Nano Kernel. Consultant further agrees to take all reasonable precautions to prevent any unauthorized disclosure of such Confidential Information including, but not limited to, having each employee of Consultant, if any, with access to any Confidential Information, execute a nondisclosure agreement containing provisions in the Nano Kernel's favor identical to Sections 2, 3 and 4 of this Agreement. Confidential Information does not include information which (i) is known to Consultant at the time of disclosure to Consultant by the Nano Kernel as evidenced by written records of Consultant, (ii) has become publicly known and made generally available through no wrongful act of Consultant, (iii) has been rightfully received by Consultant from a third party who is authorized to make such disclosure, or (iv) is approved for release by written authorization of the Nano Kernel.

(c) **Former or Current Employer's Confidential Information.** Consultant agrees that Consultant will not, during the term of this Agreement, improperly use or disclose any proprietary information or trade secrets of any former or current employer or other person or entity with which Consultant has an agreement or duty to keep in confidence information acquired by Consultant, if any, and that Consultant will not bring onto the premises of the Nano Kernel any unpublished document or proprietary information belonging to such employer, person or entity unless consented to in writing by such employer, person or entity.

(d) **Third Party Confidential Information.** Consultant recognizes that the Nano Kernel has received and will receive from third parties their confidential or proprietary information subject to a duty on the Nano Kernel's part to maintain the

Consultant agrees that Consultant owes the Nano Kernel and such third parties, during the term of this Agreement and thereafter for 1 years, a duty to hold all such confidential or proprietary information in the strictest confidence and not to disclose it to any person, firm or corporation or to use it except as necessary in carrying out the services for the Nano Kernel consistent with the Nano Kernel's agreement with such third party.

(e) Return of Materials. Upon the termination of this Agreement, or upon Nano Kernel's earlier request, Consultant will deliver to the Nano Kernel all of the Nano Kernel's property or Confidential Information that Consultant may have in Consultant's possession or control.

### 3. OWNERSHIP

The Consultant will not claim any intellectual property right on any product(s) developed by the Nano Kernel's an outcome of this Project even if the Consultant's advice may have led to the development of that product(s).

### 4. CONFLICTING OBLIGATIONS

Consultant certifies that Consultant's Personnel has no conflicting agreement or obligation that is in conflict with any of the provisions of this Agreement, or that would preclude Consultant from complying with the provisions hereof and further certifies that Consultant will not enter into any such conflicting agreement during the term of this Agreement.

### 5. USE OF CONSULTANT'S NAME

Nano Kernel shall not use Consultant's name in publicity or advertising without the prior written consent of Consultant, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed.

### 6. TERM AND TERMINATION

The term of this Agreement shall be for 18 months commencing on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018. Unless otherwise renewed in writing, this Agreement shall expire on 18 months (the "Term"). However either the Consultant or the Nano Kernel may terminate this agreement for cause which includes committing insufficient time to execute projects per an agreed timeline or misrepresenting or representing the Nano Kernel in an unprofessional way or harming the Nano Kernel through illegal means for the benefit or profit of the consultant, by the giving of ninety (90) days written notice to the other party. Upon termination, all rights and duties of the parties toward each other shall cease except Sections 2 (Confidentiality) and 3 (Ownership) shall survive termination of this Agreement.

### 7. ASSIGNMENT

Neither this Agreement nor any right hereunder or interest herein may be assigned or transferred by Consultant without the express written consent of the Nano Kernel.



8. PERMISSIONS

Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed as granting authority on Parties to negotiate on behalf of, or enter into any obligations for and on behalf of the other Party and the Party will not present himself as having a relationship with the Other Party other than as set forth in this Agreement.

09. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Karnataka without regard to conflict of law principles.

10. ENTIRE AGREEMENT; PRIOR AGREEMENTS

This instrument contains the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes any prior agreements between them, whether written or oral, with respect to the subject matter hereof. Any previous Consulting Agreement between the Nano Kernel and Consultant is hereby terminated.


12. SEVERABILITY

Memorandum of Understanding

1. 2. Delivery Partner would be offering International Certifications to the interested students from different vendors@ academic discounted price and those students who voluntarily pay the exam fees would be getting bundled training free of cost mapped to the certifications.
3. This contract in no way creates any financial binding nor does it imply that 'resource partner' has committed to provide any fixed number of student's registrations per year for the certification exams /bundled workshops, the only commitment from their end is to provide platform to address students / seminar to educate and motivate them about the various certifications and subsequent permission for registering the students who are voluntarily interested in the same.
4. As part of the special offering all exam vouchers provided to students for certifications would have a second attempt bundled free in case the student fails to clear the same in first attempt.
5. Delivery Partner would bundle a 'free of charge' faculty development Program twice a year for the faculty members of the resource partner.
6. Delivery Partner would also sponsor certification vouchers for faculty members equivalent to 20% of the total students enrolled in academic year.
7. Delivery partner would also be bundling free subscription access for 'mentorbuddy.com' for assessment and post assessment support mapped for both university curriculum and for aptitude test prep.
8. 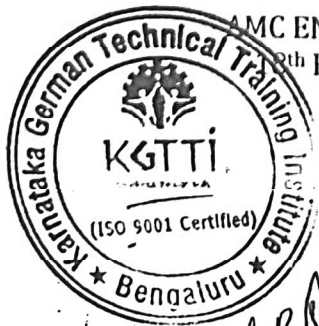

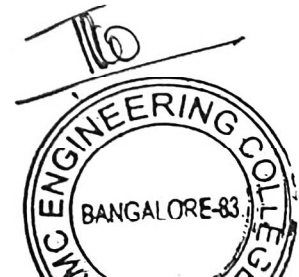

**'MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING'**

The campus has spread out in 52 acres of land with unique style of buildings for each department, having its office at 18th K.M. Bannerghatta Main Road, Bengaluru-560083, India, Karnataka India (herein after referred to as AMCEC)

This MoU is made for imparting skill development training under different training programs organized by KGTTI.

In this connection, the following points are agreed upon :

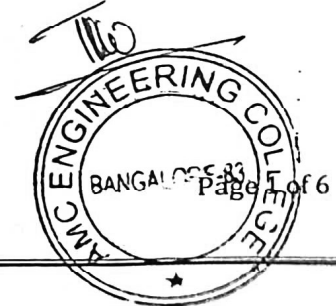
**1. Objective:**

The overall objective of the KGTTI is to provide skill development, advanced technology hands-on-Training and to enhance employment opportunities. To achieve this objective, the AMCEC will mobilize its students/ participants to undergo skill-development training to make them industry ready/Fit.

**2. Recitals:**

a. KGTTI is an organization providing technical skill training and consultancy services in advanced technology areas to students, jobseekers, school dropouts, and unemployed youth and industry personnel.

b. AMCEC is an organization engaged in imparting education to develop professional skills and prepare the students/ employees for immediate employment and provide them with a solid foundation for further education.

c. The purpose of this agreement is with reference to defining the areas of co-operation benefiting both AMCEC and KGTTI.

**This agreement witnesses as follows:**

**Areas of co-operation**

**3. Scope of Agreement:**

**KGTTI:**

- KGTTI to liaison with AMCEC for providing advanced technical skill training to the students or participants mobilized by AMCEC.
- KGTTI will provide training on the specified list of Courses (See Annexure - I) to different category of students referred by AMCEC.
- KGTTI will, unless otherwise stated utilize its premises, subject experts, software and training kits / equipment for conducting training.

**AMCEC:**

- To promote courses run by KGTTI, AMCEC will mobilize its students/Participants.
- The AMCEC will mobilize minimum of 100 students/ participants per year.
- Subject to mutual convenience, AMCEC will utilize the services of the faculty of KGTTI to render specialized domain intervention and conduct technical sessions in order to promote the KGTTI activities and motivate the students.
- AMCEC shall initiate students meet and other business promotional activities to promote the training activities of KGTTI. KGTTI shall provide technical support, presentation and promotional materials for such events.

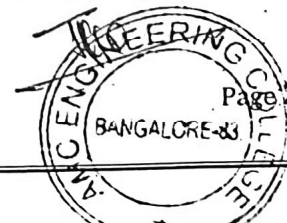
**4. Training Support & Methodology:**

The training shall be conducted at KGTTI premises or at the premises of the AMCEC if the KGTTI satisfies itself on the adequacy of the infrastructure to conduct such training programs.

- Subject to availability of adequate infrastructure, KGTTI can conduct sandwich courses where in partial training can be conducted at AMCEC premises or any other mutually agreed place with other associated activities conducted at KGTTI.
- KGTTI shall provide all support needed for imparting the necessary training to the students mobilized by AMCEC.
- Each Training program of specified duration will be carried out on mutually agreed terms.

- KGTTI will issue the Certificates to the students after successful completion of the training program. Also, since KGTTI is an authorized Training Academy for CISCO, eligible students trained in Cisco authorized courses would get certificates from CISCO along with a discount voucher (62.35%) for the Global Certification Examination (This is subject to fulfilling the Cisco norms)
- KGTTI is associated with FESTO (Festo Authorisation Certification Training Centre).
- KGTTI is also associated with Volkswagen for training in Automobile Service sector.

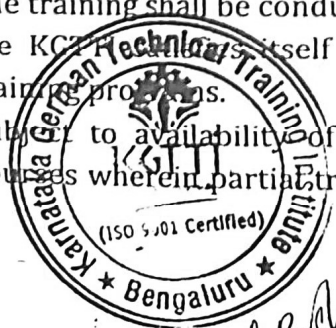
### 5. General Agreements

- Both the parties agree that no action / failure on either part, to act relating to the above proposal, will give raise to / serve as the basis for any claim, obligation or liability on either side.
- Both the parties can issue press release, make public announcement, or other such disclosure related to this Agreement without the other party's prior consent as long as it does not affect the aim, objective, ethical values and reputation of the respective Institutions.
- This Agreement may be amended with the prior written consent of both the parties.
- Subject to availability of infrastructure and other facilities at KGTTI, students mobilized by AMCEC and undergoing training at KGTTI can take up appropriate projects which may be required as part of Academic requirement at AMCEC. If required, such projects can be carried out in co-ordination with the associated faculty from AMCEC.
- Either party can cancel or terminate this Agreement by giving an advance notice of three (3) months to the other with proper justification for such act.

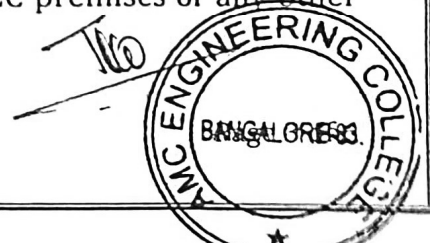
### 6. Course Deliverables:

The list of courses offered, eligibility criteria and fee structure is appended at Annexure-I.

- KGTTI will follow its standard methodologies related to conduct, student attendance, globally accepted quality norms, student feedback, internal assessments, examination, evaluation and certification, smooth & effective delivery of course content and competence building of the trainee student.
- The training shall be conducted at KGTTI premises or at the premises of the AMCEC if the KGTTI itself on the adequacy of the infrastructure to conduct such training programs.
- Subject to availability of adequate infrastructure, KGTTI can conduct sandwich courses wherein partial training can be conducted at AMCEC premises or any other

mutually agreed place with other associated activities conducted at KGTTI. The minimum & maximum student batch size for commencing a batch will be decided on mutually agreed numbers and it is as per the available seating capacity at KGTTI.

- The listed courses can vary from time to time and courses shall be added / deleted based on mutual convenience, in discussion by both the parties.
- The technical support in terms of presentations and publicity material shall be provided by KGTTI.

**NOTE:**

- The duration of training course per day is flexible to suit the requirements of the Institution / Students/Participants. This will be in mutual consultation between KGTTI and AMCEC.
- Also, KGTTI has an open mind to conduct week-end courses i.e., on Saturday and Sunday provided AMCEC mobilizes a full batch size of students in any of the streams that it would like to have the training.

**7. Course Fee and mode of payment:**

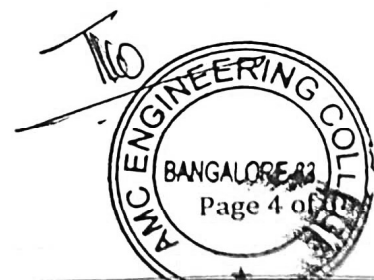
- The course fee at present is as reflected in Annexure - I. for regular programs
- Any changes in course fee in future will be communicated.
- For tailor made program course fee will of Rs.500 per student per day subject Minimum of 25 to 30 students in a batch. Duration of the program will be of 3- 5 day.
- For regular programs AMCEC shall organize upfront collection of fee from the students mobilized and arrange remittance of the same to KGTTI. KGTTI offers a discount of 20% on the listed course.
- Course fee to the students mobilized by AMCEC in minimum number of participants as per the batch size.
- KGTTI shall issue an appropriate invoice / receipt.
- For SC/ST and Minority students from Karnataka, course fee is exempted.

**Note :** All payments shall be made in favour of the Director, KGTTI - Bengaluru.

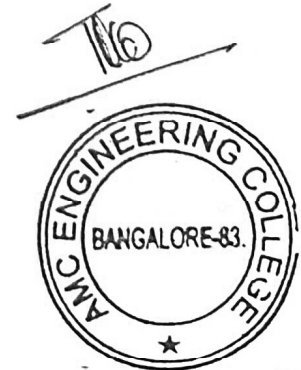
